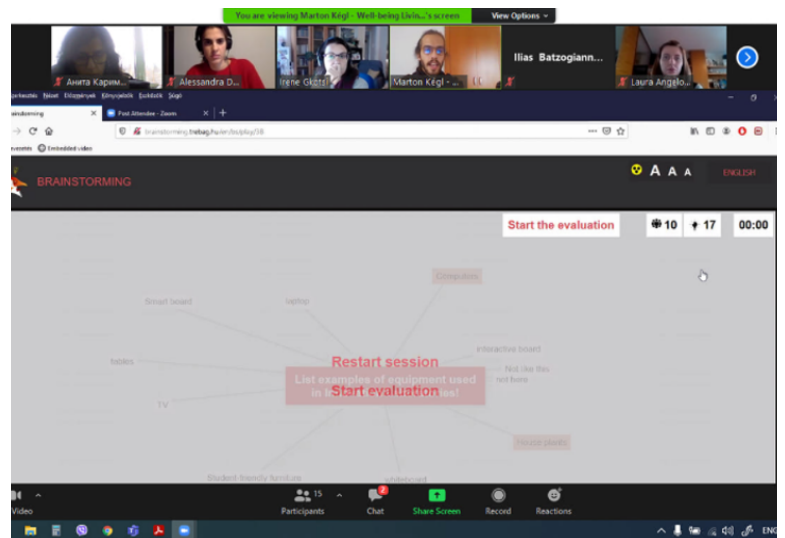

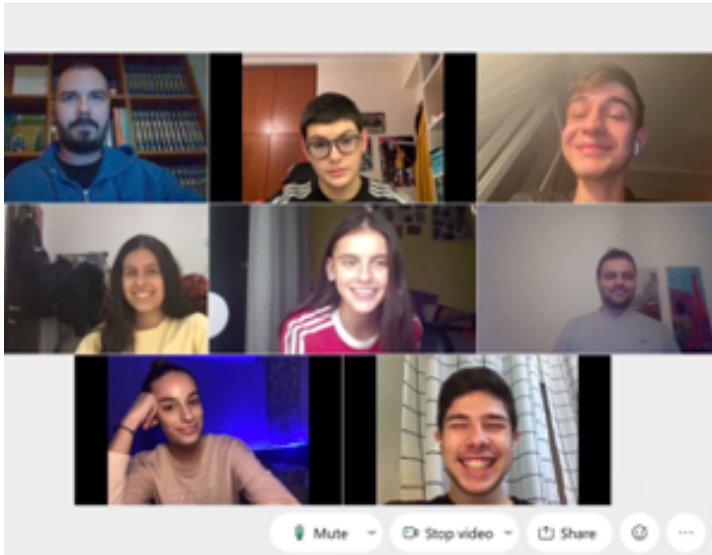
Si-Lab consortium moved online!
